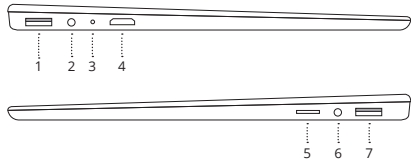

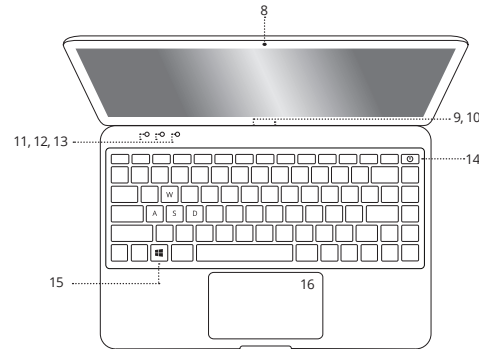


POWER LIGHT INDICATOR
